



#### **Thursday, June 11**

**9-11am Introduction to Pellet Rifles; .22 rifle**– The shooting complex will offer introductory courses on Pellet Rifles and .22's. All equipment is provided. Participants for pellet rifles must be 5 years old or older and participants for .22's must be 10 years old or older. Meet and pay at each range located in the Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. **Cost \$1/4 clips with pellet gun. Cost is \$3/10 rounds.**

**1 pm Critter Corner** – This is a very popular program for all ages. This program provides a snapshot of the different types of fish and wildlife that are found in and along the Missouri River. Participants will be able to see, touch, and sometimes smell live critters, furs, feathers, shells, skulls, etc. Meet at the Resource and Education Center. **Free.**

**3 pm Outdoor Survivor**– Learn how to survive in the outdoors – just in case! This class teaches the skills of fire starting, shelter building, and ground to air signaling. A great class for school groups, Scouts, and others. Meet at the West Shelter House. **Free.**

#### **Friday, June 12**

**9– 11 am Introduction to Archery; Muzzle-loader**– Introductory archery course for beginners 5 years or older and introductory muzzle-loader course for beginners 12 years of age and older. Participants will learn basic skills of the event of their choice – all equipment is provided. Meet and pay at the Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. **Cost is \$1/6 arrows and \$1.00 per shot.**

#### **Saturday, June 13**

**9 am-11am Introduction to Archery, Shotguns, Pellet Rifles**– The shooting complex will offer introductory courses on Pellet Rifles, Archery and Shotguns. Choose one or more activities. All equipment is provided. Meet and pay at the Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. Shotgun participants must be 12 years of age or older. Archery and Pellet Rifle participants must be 5 years of age or older. **Cost \$1/4 clips with pellet gun; \$1/6 arrows for archery; \$7/box of shotgun shells.**

**1pm; 3pm Backwater Kayaking** – Learn the basic skills of kayaking in an “off-river” backwater area. This a great place to fine-tune your kayaking skills. This is also a great way to tour our backwater area and view wildlife. Meet and pay at the Resource and Education Center. **Must be 12 years of age or older. Cost is \$12.00/person.**

**11:30 am Critter Corner**– This is a very popular program for all ages. This program provides a snapshot of the different types of fish and wildlife that are found in and along the Missouri River. **3 pm Acting Like Animals** – Learn how to describe different characteristics of animals by pretending to be one! Discover how animals fall into different groups, such as mammals vs. reptiles. Meet at the Resource and Education Center. **Free.**

**5pm; 6:15pm; 7:30pm Hayrack Park Tour (45min)** - Learn everything you wanted to know about Ponca State Park! Meet and pay at the Resource and Education Center. Please pre-register at the front desk. **Cost is \$4.00 for Adults, \$3 for 3-12 years.** Maximum of 25 people allowed per tour, minimum of 12 people.

**9-11 am Tomahawk/Atlatl Throwing Clinic**- Learn how to throw a tomahawk at a wood bull's-eye or an atlatl at our mammoth or sabretooth!!
