Platte River State Park RESTAURANT



Walter Scott, Jr. Lodge & Restaurant

Situated on a slope overlooking the Platte River, Keema Lodge was originally built in 1960 in the Early Youth Camp Functional style. It served as the focal point of the Harriet Harding Campfire Girls Camp until the site was purchased by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission in 1980. Extensive renovations of the building included the addition of an outdoor deck, the nearby 85 foot observation tower and the restaurant. The Walter Scott, Jr. Lodge Restaurant opened in August 1982. In addition to serving meals during the park season, the lodge also hosts special meetings, conferences and gatherings during the off-season.

Park History

Platte River State Park officially opened to the public in 1982, merging what once were 3 separate areas, Harriet Harding Campfire Girls Camp, Camp Esther K. Newman and a 104 acre privately owned wooded area.

The park is located about 3 miles west of Louisville in Cass County. Each year the 418 acre park is visited by thousands of people and is a nature lover's delight. Eastern hardwood forests overlap with thin fingers of tall grass prairie and Platte River floodplain woodlands. Deer, turkeys, red foxes, coyotes, and a host of bird species thrive in it's habitat.

Platte River State Park is a place to relax and unwind. The park boasts a wide range of outdoor activities, including a trail system that brings hikers and bikers close to nature. The lodging choices make the park an appealing destination for anyone who wants to spend time enjoying the beauty of the Platte River valley countryside.

21 modern cabins are available year round. 31 camper cabins and teepees are available the first weekend in May through mid-October. Cabins may be reserved online, in person or by calling the park office during business hours.
