November 21st



9-11 am Introduction to Archery- Participants, 5 years and older will learn basic archery skills. All equipment is provided. Meet and pay at the archery range in the Eric Wiebe Shooting Complex. **Cost is \$1/6 arrows.**



11:30 pm Critter Corner – This is a very popular program for all ages. This program provides a snapshot of the different types of fish and wildlife that are found in and along the Missouri River. Participants will be able to see, touch, and sometimes smell live critters, furs, feathers, shells, skulls, etc. Meet at the Resource & Education Center. **Free.**

November 22nd

9-11 am Beginners Fishing Clinic- Tying knots, fish cleaning, safety concerns, fish ID, casting and other hands-on demonstrations will be presented. Meet at the Resource & Education Center. Bait and equipment provided. **Free.**
